The Hackathon 2025 was organized on 31st October 2025 by the Research and Development Cell of *The Oxford College of Science, Arts, Commerce and Management* in association with IQAC. The theme of the event was “*Ignite Ideas. Innovate Solutions. Inspire Change.*” The program aimed to promote creativity, innovation, and analytical thinking among students by encouraging them to develop practical solutions to real-world business and social problems.
