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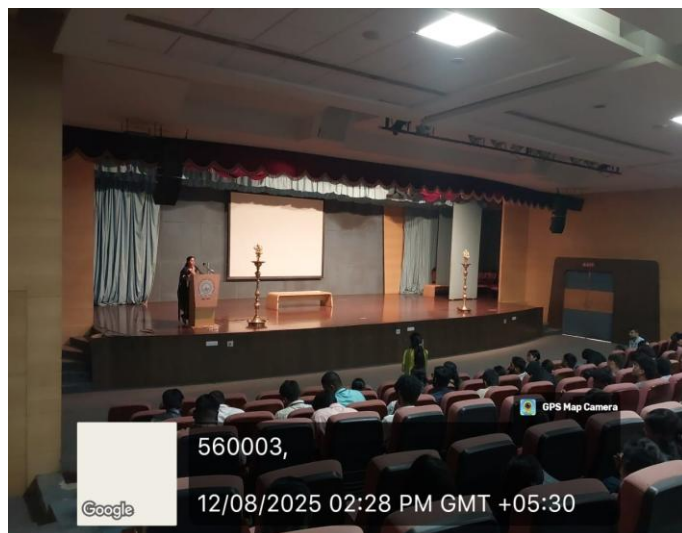
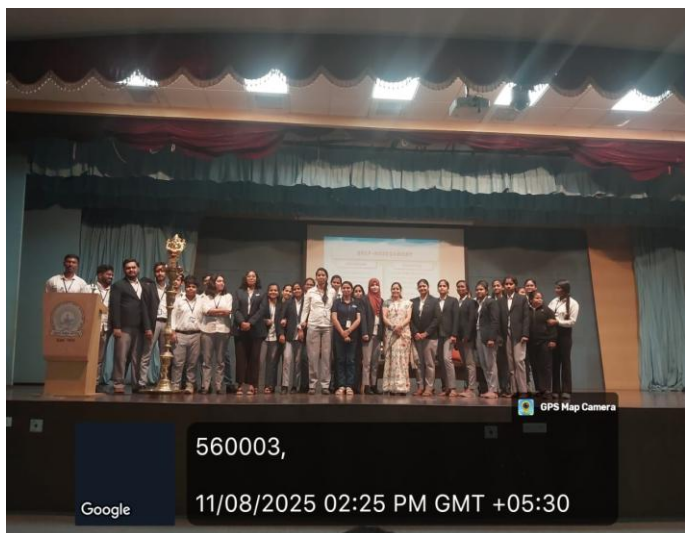

The Training and Placement cell of The Oxford College of Science, Arts, Commerce and Management organised the Three Days Soft Skill Training Programme for the Final Year Students of MBA. M.Com, BBA and B.Com. The Three Days Soft Skill Training Programme started from 11 August 2025 and continued till 13 August 2025. The Resource person for the three Days Soft Skill Training Programme was Ms. Neha Anjum, soft Skill Trainer, Bengaluru. The programme started by 10:30 am and ended up by 3:00 pm on all the three days.

On Day 1 (11 August 2025), the three Days Soft Skill Training Programme was inaugurated by Dr. H.B.Bhuvaneswari, Principal, The Oxford College of Science, Arts, Commerce and Management and the resource person Ms. Neha Anjum, soft Skill Trainer, Bengaluru addressed the students about the programme. On the first day programme, the students were given a detailed information about personality development and basic etiquettes which has to be followed in the interviews.
